

London Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ) – Summary of Key Information

Please find below key information about the London Ultra Low Emission Zone (ULEZ):

- The ULEZ operates 24/7 throughout the year, except on Christmas Day.
- It covers all London boroughs but not the M25.
- If your vehicle does not meet the ULEZ emissions standards, you must pay a daily charge to drive within the zone.
- The emissions standards apply to cars, motorcycles, vans, specialist vehicles up to 3.5 tonnes, and minibuses up to 5 tonnes.
- The ULEZ emissions standards require Euro 4 (NOx) for petrol cars, vans, minibuses, and specialist vehicles and Euro 6 (NOx and PM) for diesel cars, vans, minibuses, and specialist vehicles.
- As a general guide, all new diesel vans sold from September 2016 should meet the Euro 6 standard, and all new petrol vans registered with the DVLA from January 2006 should meet the Euro 4 standard.

Exemptions

- Exemptions are available for minibuses used for Boys' Brigade purposes that do not meet the ULEZ standard.
- If the exemption is approved, it will be **valid until 26th October 2025**.
- You can check if your vehicle is eligible and apply for exemption on the TfL website.
